
4. Attendance for the guest lecture/Seminar is compulsory.

- (Practical Sessional 20 marks + MSBTE Practical Examination 80 marks) = Total 100 marks in each **Practical subject** head PCI syllabus E.R. 1991 and E.R.2020
- Students with certified manuals will only be eligible for practical examination.
- Any kind of unfair means during practical/ theory examination is punishable.
