# **Important Instructions:**

- The academic performance/ attendance report of defaulter students may be communicated to parents.
- (Theory Sessional 20 marks + MSBTE Theory Examination 80 marks) = Total 100 marks in each
   Theory subject head for PCI syllabus w.e.f. 1991.
- (Practical Sessional 20 marks + MSBTE Practical Examination 80 marks) = Total 100 marks in each
   Practical subject head PCI syllabus w.e.f. 1991.
- Students with certified manuals will only be eligible for practical examination.
- Any kind of unfair means during practical/ theory examination is punishable.
- Before beginning the exam make sure you have a good internet connection.
- · Do not cheat with dummy and proxy entry into the online classes.
