Important Instructions:

- 2. First week formalities: (For newly admitted students)







- Students shall fill up enrollment form/ eligibility form as per the schedule notified after completion of admission process
- Student shall collect identity card from office.
- 3. 80% attendance for theory and practical is mandatory; failing which he/she would be detained / disallowed for the Sessional as well as University Examination.
- 4. Attendance for the guest lecture/Seminar is compulsory.

- 6. No student shall come late or leave earlier for classes and must follow the time table.

B. Pharm.-Modalities of Examination:

- There would be two sessional exams for the continuous evaluation of the students, conducted during each semester for theory as well as practical, each of thirty and forty marks respectively.
- The passing percentage for theory and for practical is 50%.
- The academic performance/ attendance report of defaulter students may be communicated to parents.
- (Continuous Assessment 10 + Sessional 15 marks + End semester Exam 75 marks) = Total 100 marks in each Theory subject head for PCI syllabus as per Shivaji University, Kolhapur w.e.f. 2017-18.
- (Continuous Assessment 05 +Sessional 10 marks + End semester Exam 35 marks) = Total 50 marks in each Practical subject head for PCI syllabus as per Shivaji University, Kolhapur w.e.f. 2017-18.
- Students with certified journals will only be eligible for practical examination.

• Any kind of unfair means during practical/ theory examination is punishable.
