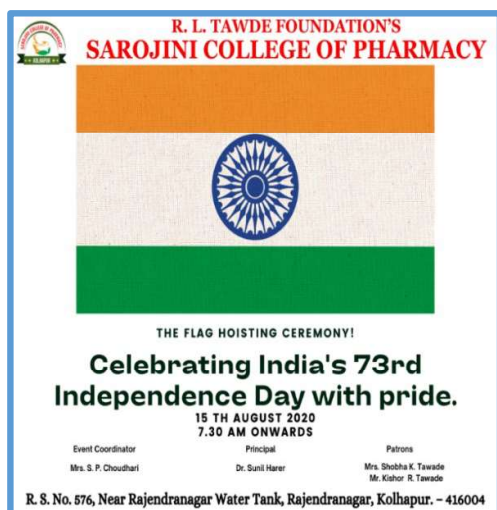
Objective: to spread the importance of the constitution and the thoughts and ideas of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar

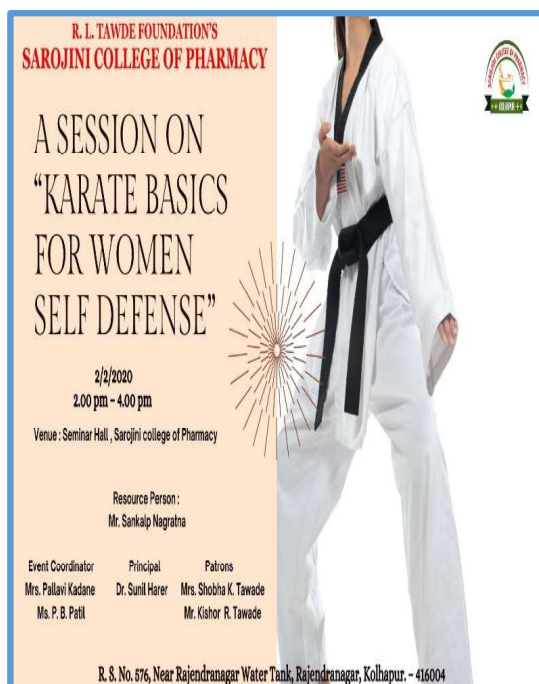

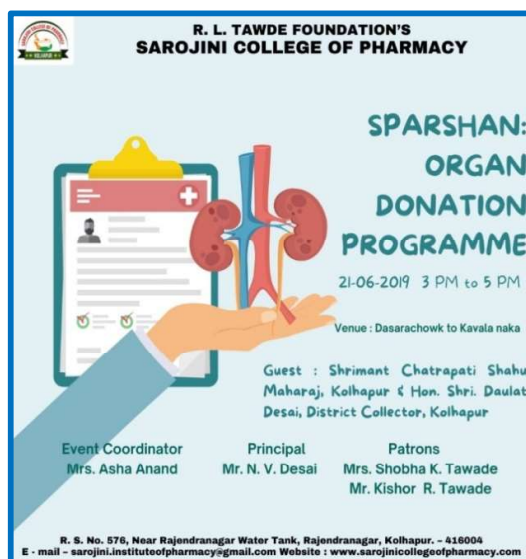
