ICRA views pharmaceutical sector headwinds in remission, US FDA inspections gain momentum



ICRA expects the revenues of the sample set of 25 Indian pharmaceutical companies which account for 60% of the overall industry to grow by 7-9% in FY2024, post a YoY growth of 10% in FY2023. The same will be primarily supported by 8-10% expansion in the domestic market and 6-8% growth in the US market, while revenues from the European market and emerging markets are expected to rise by 3-5% and 8-10%, respectively. The overall

credit profile of Indian pharmaceutical companies is expected to remain healthy, supported by their stable earnings profile, comfortable leverage and coverage metrics, and strong liquidity position.



WHO releases new guidance on HIV viral suppression and scientific updates IAS 2023

The World Health Organization (WHO) released new scientific and normative guidance on



HIV at the 12th International IAS (the International AIDS Society) Conference on HIV Science in Brisbane from 23 to 26 July 2023.New WHO guidance and an accompanying Lancet systematic review released describe the role of HIV viral suppression and undetectable levels of virus in both improving individual health and halting onward HIV transmission. The guidance describes key HIV

viral load thresholds and the approaches to measure levels of virus against these thresholds; for example, people living with HIV who achieve an undetectable level of virus by consistent use of antiretroviral therapy, do not transmit HIV to their sexual partner(s) and are at low risk of transmitting HIV vertically to their children.
