

- **Notification of Acceptance of Abstracts: 12th April, 2025**
- **Date of Poster Presentation in Online Mode: 24th April, 2025**
- **Offline mode:**
- All candidates should submit the abstract by email on etddtr.conference.2025@gmail.com. Selected candidates will be intimated for acceptance in Poster or Oral Presentation. Oral presentation will be only in offline mode.
- **Online mode:** Abstracts should be communicated on same email, for selection in poster presentation.

RULES FOR ABSTRACT PREPARATION

- **The research work included in the abstract should not have been published earlier content.**
 - **Only one abstract per presenting author will be accepted. Abstracts submitted by registered participants will only be considered.**
 - **Title:** The title should be concise and should accurately reflect the content of the abstract.
 - **Affiliation:** Presenting Author, Co-Authors (underline the presenting author), with their affiliations.
 - Abstract body text shall be arranged under the following headings as:
 - Introduction:** Background information of the research work;
 - Methods:** Briefly, describe the experimental work;
 - Results:** Discuss the data resulting from the research work;
 - Conclusions:** Highlight significance of the results.
 - **Keywords:** Provide 3 – 4 keywords.
 - Restrict abstract text to a maximum of 350 words. Full paper should have maximum of 3000 words.
 - Font style of Times New Roman with a font size of 12, single line-spacing shall be used.
 - Guidelines for the preparation of poster and templates for oral/poster will be shared later.
- **Best paper awards (oral and poster) will be given in form of certificate and prizes.**
 - **Full papers of selected abstracts after peer review will be published in a book with ISBN number, in the form of Proceedings of National Conference.**

RULES FOR SCIENTIFIC POSTER PRESENTATION

Please follow the guidelines below when preparing your poster presentation:

- Include an abstract on your poster to ensure viewers can follow it.
- The poster must be printed on flex and **MUST NOT BE LARGER** than 1 x 1 metre, with some space left at the top to stick or pin the poster to the display setting.
- Include the title of the paper, followed by the authors' names and their affiliations at the top of the poster.
- Avoid excessive amounts of text, instead, provide the information in short bullet points.
- Poster number labels will be provided on site and will be placed above your poster on the board.
- The sections including Introduction, Methodology, Results and Conclusions sections are advised. Double spaced text is recommended.
- **Abstracts selected for Oral presentation will be notified about the guidelines for presentation by e-mail.**




